In today's Gospel St John describes the miracle of the multiplication of the five barley loaves (*barley was the food of the poor*) and two fish. It was all the little boy had. He gave all to Jesus in total trust and in great generosity. Jesus transformed this great act of self-giving into something greater. The little boy's gift became enough to feed well over 5,000 people. This small gift, given with enormous love, in the Lord's hands, produced nourishment and repose for thousands. This is the prefiguration of the Sacrament of the Eucharist. For after Jesus gave thanks, blessed, broke and shared with the crowds, there was enough left to feed the 12 tribes of Israel (12 baskets), just as the Eucharist nourishes all the tribes of the new Israel, the Church.
